A proposal under the Call "Enterprise Europe Network 2015 - 2020" submitted by consortia from Republic of Srpska which consists of Republic Agency for the Development of SMEs, Chamber of Commerce and Industry Republic of Srpska, University of Banja Luka, University East Sarajevo and Innovation Center Banja Luka has been favorably evaluated by the EC – Executive Agency for Small and Medium – sized Enterprises (EASME). The aim of this call was to establish the Enterprise Europe Network for the period 2015-2020 in geographic areas where no Enterprise Europe Network consortia have emerged yet. The Network aims to contribute to the objectives of the Competitiveness of Enterprises and Small and Medium - sized Enterprises (COSME) program by facilitating access to European and international markets for European SMEs and by providing growth - oriented, integrated business and innovation support services that help strengthen the competitiveness and sustainability of European enterprises. The Network primarily addresses European SMEs that seek to exploit new opportunities in the Single Market, but also in third countries.

# REPUBLIC OF SRPSKA SIGNS A LETTER OF INTENT TO OPEN A NEW ENTERPRISE CITY – FIRST IN THE BALKANS



Prime Minister of the Republic of Srpska Mrs. Zeljka Cvijanovic and Managing Director of the Competitiveness and Enterprise Development Project of Babson Global from Boston, Shanker Singham, signed in Banja Luka a Letter of Intent to establish an Enterprise City. Prime Minister Cvijanovic stated that the Letter of Intent referred to cooperation regarding the establishment of the entrepreneurs' city in the Republic of Srpska at the location which would be identified in the forthcoming period. As Prime Minister said, the aim of this cooperation was to create such business environment that would motivate foreign and domestic investors to invest stressing that Babson College of which Babson Global was a part, was the leading educator in the USA in entrepreneurship and development of entrepreneurs' initiatives.

## **REPUBLIC OF SRPSKA REPRESENTATIVE AT THE ARLEM PLENARY SESSION**



Republic of Srpska's representative attended the sixth Plenary Session of the Euro Mediterranean Regional and Local Assembly – ARLEM in Antalya, Turkey.
