## FLOOD RELIEF TO REPUBLIC OF SRPSKA



State of emergency is declared in Republic of Srpska due to immense floods that have paralyzed the life of the country. This is one of the

worst natural disasters in the recorded history of Bosnia and Herzegovina but also of the region as a whole. Rising rivers forced hundreds from their homes and blocked traffic on the main roads to the neighbouring Serbia and Croatia. Cut in energy supply and shortages in drinking water hit thousands of homes. Many fear of the coming period as the flood destroyed most of the agricultural lands and deprived the people from their future income. All available resources and rescue teams of Republic of Srpska are enaged in their full capacity but we are entering the critical phase of flood protection.

In the view of all the above said, we are kindly asking you to assist us, to the best of your abilities. We are in urgent need of financial help and different products such are clothes, desinfection means and various water equipment. # SARAJEVO: MEETINGS OF ALDA AND LDA BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA (MOSTAR, PRIJEDOR, ZAVIDOVIĆI)

On 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> March, Delegation composed by Dženana Dedić (LDA Mostar), Jasna Zvekić (LDA Zavidovići), joined by Dragan Došen (LDA Prijedor), and led by Stanka Parać Damjanović (ALDA Regional Programme Coordinator), visited in Sarajevo the Delegation of the European Union, UNDP Head Office, USAID Head Office and the Office of the Council of Europe.

The main purpose of the visit was to introduce the work of in local communities and provide information about implemented and planned projects in relevant areas in order to strengthen the capacity of civil society, the development of local democracy, social services, youth empowerment, as well as networking with partners in the EU and neighbouring countries in the region.

Especially important for all LDAs in Bosnia and Herzegovina are the planned activities of UNDP in strengthening local democracy through programs LOD (Reinforcement of Local Democracy), as well as the EU Delegation and USAID program in the field of reconciliation in local communities. Very important for the future activities of ALDA (Association of Local Democracy Agencies) in BiH is the recognition of Local Democracy Agencies as relevant partners, which have necessary human resources, long standing experience and organizational capacity to successfully develop and implement projects in their local communities and at the regional level.

and urban development organized by the Committee of the Regions and the European Commission's Regional Policy Directorate General. Agency for Development of SMEs of the Republic of Srpska will be a part of the conglomerate "Adriatic – Ionian Macro Region" together with actors from the regions of Italy, Slovenia, Croatia, Serbia, Montenegro and Greece co-participating. This is the sixth consecutive time that Republic of Srpska participates in Open Days.

Republic of Srpska's representative attended the fifth Plenary Session of the Euro Mediterranean Regional and Local Assembly – ARLEM.
